

Meridian insurance agent license revoked

BOISE ID – The Idaho Department of Insurance has issued an order revoking the Idaho producer license of Meridian resident Valeria Willis, effective November 21, 2016, and imposing an administrative penalty of \$4,000.

The Department found that Willis was dishonest in submitting two insurance claims to AFLAC. In both cases, the service claimed was not provided, yet she accepted the payments from the insurance company. In doing so, Willis demonstrated untrustworthiness and was a source of loss to the insurance company. Less than one month ago, the Department revoked the license of Erik Astheimer for participating in the same practice with the same company.

“Idaho Code clearly outlines conduct which can lead to investigation and revocation of an agent’s license,” said Department Director Dean Cameron. “Fraudulent behavior builds distrust within the industry and will not be tolerated.”
