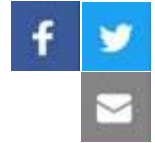

**Dean Cameron Elected to Leadership Post of National Assoc. of Insurance Commissioners**  
***Idaho Department of Insurance Director will serve as the organization's Secretary-Treasurer***

BOISE, ID – Dean Cameron, who has served as Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance the past three years, has been elected Secretary-Treasurer of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Director Cameron is the first Idaho Insurance Commissioner ever elected to NAIC leadership. He and his fellow NAIC leaders, elected at the organization's recent Fall National Meeting, officially take office on January 1, 2019.

Joining Director Cameron on the new NAIC governing body are President Eric Cioppa, Maine Bureau of Insurance superintendent; President-Elect Raymond G. Farmer, Director of the South Carolina Department of Insurance; and Gordon I. Ito, Commissioner of the Hawaii Insurance Division.

"I am humbled and honored to be elected by my peers," said Cameron. "I am proud to say Idaho is recognized as a thoughtful and creative leader in the insurance industry."

Director Cameron was appointed to his current state post by Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter in June 2015. He has more than three decades of experience in the insurance industry, and served 25 years in the Idaho State Senate, including eight terms as Chair of the Senate Finance Committee, and Co-chair of the state's budget committee.

The NAIC is the U.S. standard-setting and regulatory support organization created and governed by the chief insurance regulators from the 50 states, the District of Columbia and five U.S. territories.
