**STIPULATION**

COMES NOW the Department of Insurance, State of Idaho (“Department”), by and through its counsel, Mitchell E. Toryanski, Deputy Attorney General, and NATIONAL UNION FIRE INSURANCE COMPANY OF PITTSBURGH, PA.(“NATIONAL UNION”), by and through its undersigned authorized representative and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. NATIONAL UNION, a Pennsylvania corporation, is duly authorized as an insurer by the State of Idaho, holding certificate of authority number 328 and is therefore subject

to the provisions of Title 41, Idaho Code, and to the Rules and Regulations of the Department promulgated thereunder. NATIONAL UNION holds NAIC number 19445.

2. During 2007-2008, NATIONAL UNION issued an insurance policy to Boise State University using Form S30494NUFIC-ID (Boise State) – Student Blanket Accident and Sickness Policy; Form S30495NUFIC-ID (Boise State) – Student Blanket Accident and Sickness Certificate of Coverage; and Form S30501NUFIC-ID (Boise State) – Application for Student Blanket Accident and Sickness Policy.
3. NATIONAL UNION delivered, or issued for delivery in this state, the forms listed in paragraph 2 before filing them with the Director as required by Idaho Code § 41-1812.
4. NATIONAL UNION agrees and stipulates to pay an administrative penalty for the failure to file in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) within thirty (30) days of entry of the attached ORDER by the Director.
5. The parties agree that the terms of this Stipulation are appropriate and proper under the circumstances referenced herein, and that they have entered into this Stipulation knowingly, voluntarily, and with full knowledge of any rights they may be waiving thereby. Additionally, the parties hereby waive the right to seek reconsideration and judicial review of the attached order.


