

The Idaho Department of Insurance **PROVISIONAL LICENSE FOR RESIDENT PRODUCERS**. To qualify, you must do the following:

- a. Sign up for and take the AD Banker provisional course plus comprehensive exam for each line of authority and pass with 80% score or better. Our website link has a specific link for these courses:
<https://www.adbanker.com/staterequirements.aspx?state=id&line=pl> **ALTERNATIVE:** you may purchase study materials from any other Idaho approved vendor, with the option to sign up for the exam-only through AD Banker.
- b. Put in application for a Temporary Resident Producer license through Sircon services, when that is available. Attach AD Banker certification of passed exam(s), and any background documentation needed. **This application will need to be submitted by the sponsoring carrier.** Fee is \$80 and the appointment for the sponsoring carrier will be activated when the license is issued
- c. This license will be valid for up to six months, or until test sites are once again available, at which time, the temporary licensee will have 30 days to pass the state exam(s) and get fingerprinted through PSI. Submit results (pass slips and receipts, etc.) to the Department by fax (208-334-4398) or email (agent@doi.idaho.gov) in order to change license status from provisional to permanent. The application process will not need to be repeated or new fees collected by the state and any existing appointments will transfer to the permanent license.
- d. Should background report, once that is available, have discrepancies with what has been reported on the original application, this would be grounds for revocation of the provisional license and reapplication would not be possible for one year past that date.
