The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance having received an Order from the State of Arizona Department of Insurance wherein the Arizona license of DAVID ALAN JONES (JONES) was revoked, and THE TRUCKERS' CHOICE, INC. (TRUCKERS) firm license was revoked; upon further review of the record herein and having verified the same, the Director does hereby make the following findings and enters a Summary Order as follows:

- That JONES of 5322 N 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue Suite M, Glendale, Arizona, 85301-6765, was licensed in Arizona as a producer and that an Order had been entered on or about September 10, 2009 by the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona revoking JONES's Arizona license.
- 2. That TRUCKERS' of 5322 N 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue Suite M, Glendale, Arizona, 85301-6765, was licensed in Arizona as a producer and that an Order had been entered on or about September 10, 2009 by the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona revoking TRUCKERS' Arizona license.
- 3. That notification of said Order was received by the Idaho Department of Insurance on or about October 5, 2009.
- 4. That JONES and TRUCKERS' home state is Arizona.
- 5. That the Order revoking JONES and TRUCKERS' Arizona licenses were grounded on the conduct of the parties constituting improperly withholding, misappropriating or converting any monies or properties received in the course of doing insurance business contrary to Arizona law.
- 6. That JONES has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident producer since the date of initial issue license on April 22, 2004. The license number, as identified above, is No. 111895.
- 7. That TRUCKERS' has been continuously license as an Idaho non-resident producer firm since the date of initial issue license on April 29, 2004. The license number, as identified above, is No. 112120.
- 8. That pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance shall suspend for not more than twelve months, or

shall revoke, or refuse to continue any license issued under Title 41, Chapter 10, Idaho Code where the Director has received a final order of revocation

from the insurance regulatory official of the licensee's home state.

9. Therefore, based upon the foregoing, in accord with Idaho Code § 41-1016(2),

and in consideration of the premises;

IT IS ORDERED that the Idaho non-resident producer license no. 111895 of DAVID

ALAN JONES is hereby REVOKED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Idaho non-resident producer firm license no.

112120 of THE TRUCKERS' CHOICE, INC.'s is hereby REVOKED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DAVID ALAN JONES shall immediately surrender

and return his non-resident producer license no. 111895 to the Idaho Department of Insurance;

and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that THE TRUCKERS' CHOICE, INC. shall immediately

surrender its non-resident producer firm license no. 112120 to the Idaho Department of Insurance

at the address provided hereinabove.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

#### NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273.

The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
