ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL FROM MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT PLAN N MARKET

WHEREAS, UNITED OF OMAHA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY ("United of Omaha") notified the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Department") by electronic letter submitted April 13, 2011, that United of Omaha intends to withdraw and discontinue marketing Medicare Supplement Plan N Policy UM31-22552 in Idaho effective May 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS, United of Omaha has represented to the Department that it will renew and service all its existing in-force Medicare Supplement Plan N contracts in Idaho, which, as of the date of United of Omaha's letter, was represented to be 748;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a, United of Omaha is permitted to withdraw and discontinue marketing its Medicare Supplement Plan N in Idaho effective May 13, 2011.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that United of Omaha shall not file a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare supplement benefit plan as the discontinued form or offer such products in Idaho prior to April 13, 2016, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* section 67-5246(4), Idaho Code.

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal this final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of (a) the service date of this final order, (b) an order denying petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* section 67-5273,
