**ORDER PERMITTING DEVIATION  
FROM 2012 WORKER'S  
COMPENSATION RATES**

WHEREAS, SENTRY CASUALTY COMPANY (Applicant) is a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI); and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has applied to the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Department) for permission to deviate from certain Idaho worker's compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2012, by applying a rate of \$0.00 (no charge) for Catastrophe (other than Certified Acts of Terrorism) coverage associated with its Idaho worker's compensation coverage, which rate represents a negative one hundred percent (-100%) deviation; and by applying a rate of \$0.01 for Terrorism coverage associated with its Idaho worker's compensation coverage, which rate represents a negative fifty percent (-50%) deviation; and

WHEREAS, both the Applicant and the NCCI have indicated in writing that they each voluntarily waive the right to the hearing on the application authorized by § 41-1614(2) of the Idaho Insurance Code and the contested case provisions of the Idaho Administrative Procedure Act, Idaho Code § 67-5241 *et seq.*, as well as all rights attendant thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Insurance, having read and being fully apprised of the Applicant's request to deviate from certain Idaho worker's compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2012 as set forth above, has determined that the rate deviations requested in the application are justified;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614, the Applicant's request to apply a rate of \$0.00 (no charge) for Catastrophe (other than Certified Acts of Terrorism) coverage and a rate of \$0.01 for Terrorism coverage associated with the Applicant's Idaho worker's compensation coverage is GRANTED. This deviation from the Idaho worker's compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2012 shall take effect January 1, 2012, and shall remain in effect for one year from that date unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.
