**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING  
IDAHO NON-RESIDENT INSURANCE  
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) has received notice of the issuance of an order by the Colorado Insurance Commissioner, which order revoked the Colorado resident insurance producer license issued to BETHANY A. WEBB (WEBB), effective February 1, 2012. Upon review of such order and the “Stipulation for Entry of Final Agency Order,” a stipulation entered into on or about January 31, 2012, between WEBB and the Colorado Division of Insurance, underlying the aforementioned Colorado Insurance Commissioner’s order, and, pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. WEBB, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of Colorado.

2. On or about January 31, 2012, the Colorado Division of Insurance and WEBB entered into a "Stipulation for Entry of Final Agency Order" in Division File No. EC5614, whereby the Colorado Division of Insurance and WEBB agreed: (a) that WEBB had violated Colorado insurance statutes by, among other acts, engaging in the improper conversion of an insurer's property for her own use, committing an unfair trade practice and/or fraud, and using fraudulent and/or dishonest practices and demonstrating untrustworthiness; and (b) that WEBB's Colorado resident insurance producer license would be revoked as a result of her admission to engaging in such acts.

3. On February 1, 2012, the Colorado Insurance Commissioner entered a "Final Agency Order," designated as Final Agency Order No. O-12-099, revoking WEBB's Colorado resident insurance producer license, effective as of the date of such order.

4. WEBB has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident insurance producer, holding license number 301308 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on November 6, 2008 to the present date.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue from the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing,

the Director finds that such circumstances justify the revocation of WEBB's Idaho non-resident insurance producer license pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2).

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Non-Resident Insurance Producer License No. 301308, issued to BETHANY A. WEBB, is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that WEBB shall immediately return Idaho Non-Resident Insurance Producer License No. 301308 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

### **NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS**

This is a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal this order by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of (a) the service date of this final order, (b) an order denying petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21)

days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
