ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT FOR REVOCATION OF NON-RESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Having reviewed the record on file in this matter, including a letter received from CHARLES JOSEPH McKELVEY (the Respondent) on May 29, 2012, the Director of the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Director), hereby finds as follows:

1. On May 16, 2012, the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Department) filed with the Director, acting in his quasi-judicial capacity, an administrative complaint, seeking revocation of the Respondent's Idaho non-resident insurance producer license. The basis for such complaint included a summary revocation for cause of the Respondent's Kansas non-resident insurance producer license ordered by the Commission of Insurance of the State of Kansas. A second basis for the Department's administrative complaint was the issuance of an order by the Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas suspending the Respondent's non-resident insurance producer license in that state, based on the termination of the Respondent's resident insurance producer license in the state of New York.

- 2. On May 29, 2012, the Department received a letter submitted by the Respondent, wherein the Respondent represented that he has taken steps to have the Kansas revocation order converted to a voluntary license surrender in lieu of a revocation, and expects an order reflecting that result to be issued in the near future. The Respondent also represented in such letter that the Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas has indicated that the Respondent's license status in that state will soon be converted from a suspension to a voluntary surrender.
- 3. The Respondent has agreed to provide the Department with copies of the updated orders from the states of Kansas and Arkansas referenced in paragraph 2 above as soon as they are available.
- 4. In the Respondent's letter to the Department received on May 29, 2012, the Respondent requested that, in view of the circumstance set forth above, the Department's action for revocation of the Respondent's Idaho non-resident license be dismissed, and that the Respondent be allowed to voluntarily surrender his Idaho nonresident insurance producer license in full resolution of this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent's Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License No. 292178 is deemed voluntarily surrendered, and the Complaint for Revocation of Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License seeking revocation of the Respondent's Idaho non-resident insurance producer license is HEREBY DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE. This matter may be reopened should the Respondent fail to produce the revised orders by the Kansas and Arkansas insurance regulators as set forth above within a time period deemed reasonable by the Director.
