ORDER AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL FROM MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT MARKET

On November 25, 2013, the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Department), received from UNITED OF OMAHA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY (UNITED OF OMAHA) notice of its intent to withdraw from the Medicare supplement market in Idaho, effective December 26, 2013, by withdrawing from sale in Idaho all of UNITED OF OMAHA's Idaho Medicare supplement plans, which plans are identified as policy forms UM20-21698 (Plan A), UM23-21699 (Plan F), UM24-21700 (Plan G), and UM30-22551 (Plan M). UNITED OF OMAHA acknowledged in such notice that its withdrawal of such plans for sale in Idaho will prohibit UNITED OF OMAHA from filing for approval in Idaho a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare supplement benefit plans as the

discontinued forms for a period of five (5) years from the date of UNITED OF OMAHA's November 25, 2013, notice to the Department, pursuant to the requirements of IDAPA

18.01.54.030.04.b.

UNITED OF OMAHA represented to the Department that the company will continue to

service its existing in-force Medicare supplement policies in Idaho, which UNITED OF

OMAHA represented consists of four thousand four hundred seven (4,407) policies.

UNITED OF OMAHA's notice of its intent to withdraw from the Medicare supplement

market in Idaho appears to comply with the notice requirements to the Department's Director

(Director) as set forth in IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a.

The Director, having reviewed the foregoing and the requirements of IDAPA

18.01.54.030.04, and good cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA

18.01.54.030.04.a, that UNITED OF OMAHA is authorized to withdraw from the Medicare

supplement market in Idaho, effective December 26, 2013.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b, that

UNITED OF OMAHA shall not file with the Department a new policy form or certificate form

of the same type for the same standard Medicare supplement benefit plan as the discontinued

forms prior to November 25, 2018.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This Order constitutes a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The Director will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
