**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING  
IDAHO NON-RESIDENT  
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director), has received notice of the entry of an order by the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance, which order revoked the Arizona insurance producer license issued to RODRIGO ALBERTO TREVINO (TREVINO), as further described below. Upon review of such order and, pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. TREVINO, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of Arizona.

2. On or about June 2, 2014, the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance entered an order in Case No. 14A-014-INS, revoking TREVINO's Arizona insurance producer license.

3. TREVINO has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident insurance producer, holding license number 466242 from the initial issuance of such license on October 28, 2013, to the present date.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of TREVINO's Idaho non-resident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2).

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License No. 466242, issued to TREVINO, is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TREVINO shall immediately return Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License No. 466242 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

**NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS**

This Order constitutes a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The Director will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

## **NOTICE REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS**

The foregoing is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. As such, it is a public record and is public information that may be disclosed to other states and reported to companies as to which the Respondent is actively appointed. This information will be reported to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) and will appear in the online searchable database of the Idaho Department of Insurance. The Respondent should be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any insurance license application and must be reported to any and all states in which the Respondent holds an insurance license.


