ORDER PERMITTING DEVIATION FROM 2015 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES

On October 31, 2014, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) received from HARTFORD CASUALTY INSURANCE COMPANY (HARTFORD CASUALTY), an Indiana-domiciled insurer licensed to transact workers' compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 1699, and a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI), a request for permission to deviate from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2015 by a uniform percentage <u>decrease</u> of ten percent (10%).

HARTFORD CASUALTY and the NCCI have each indicated in writing that they do not request a hearing on the deviation request.

ORDER PERMITTING DEVIATION FROM 2015 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES - 1

The Department's Director (Director), having reviewed and being fully apprised of HARTFORD CASUALTY's request to deviate from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2015, and the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1614, has determined that the requested rate deviation is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614, that HARTFORD CASUALTY's request to deviate by a uniform percentage <u>decrease</u> of ten percent (10%) from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2015, exclusive of terrorism rates, is GRANTED. This deviation from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2015 shall take effect on January 1, 2015, and shall remain in effect for one year from that date unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.






