ORDER AUTHORIZING BLOCK NONRENEWAL

On March 23, 2022, the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Department") received notice from GRANGE INSURANCE ASSOCIATION ("GRANGE") of its intent to discontinue offering and to block nonrenew its personal inland marine watercraft policies delivered or issued for delivery in Idaho. GRANGE represented its proposed block nonrenewal would affect approximately 26 policies in Idaho, and that the affected policies will be nonrenewed over their natural expiration dates or transferred as an endorsement to their personal homeowner policies on or after July 21, 2022, with each policyholder receiving at least 60 days' notice of nonrenewal.

The Director of the Department ("Director"), having reviewed the foregoing and Idaho Code § 41-1841(1), and acting pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-210(2), finds that the proposed effective date of the contemplated block nonrenewals comply with the 120-day notice requirement to the Director, as set forth in Idaho Code § 41-1841(1) Based on these findings, and good cause appearing,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that GRANGE is authorized, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1841, to effectuate a block nonrenewal of its personal inland marine watercraft policies delivered or issued in Idaho, **beginning no sooner than July 21, 2022,** which is 120 days after GRANGE'S notice to the Director. GRANGE shall provide advance notice to policyholders affected by the nonrenewals authorized by this Order in accordance with Idaho law and the notice provisions in GRANGE'S applicable insurance policies.

This Order is a final order of the Director and is effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
