**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING  
IDAHO NONRESIDENT  
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice that, on March 25, 2022, the State of Florida, Department of Financial Services issued a *Consent Order* that suspended Omar Rodriguez’ (“Rodriguez”) license to conduct the business of insurance in Florida for three months from the date of the *Consent Order*. Upon reviewing the *Consent Order*, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order Revoking Rodriguez’s Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 546921.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Rodriguez, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed in his home state of Florida as a 2-20 General Lines Agent, under license number W283670.
2. On March 17, 2022, the State of Florida, Department of Financial Services and Rodriguez entered into a *Settlement Stipulation for Consent Order* in case No. 293422-22-AG. In the *Stipulation*, the parties agreed, among other things, that Rodriguez’s Florida license would be suspended for three months and he would pay a \$3,000 administrative penalty .
3. The underlying facts, per the *Stipulation*, were as follows. The Florida Department of Financial Services investigated Rodriguez in his capacity as a 2-20 General Lines Agent licensee. At the conclusion, it was alleged that Rodriguez aided and abetted an unauthorized insurer in the

solicitation and sale of insurance. Rodriguez agreed it would be in his best interest to settle the matter instead of litigating it and, on March 17, 2022, the parties signed the *Stipulation*.

4. On March 25, 2022, the Director of the Florida Division of Insurance Agent & Agency Services signed a *Consent Order* that approved and incorporated the *Stipulation*, suspended Rodriguez's license for three months commencing March 25, 2022, and imposed a \$3,000 administrative penalty.

5. Rodriguez has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 546921 since its issuance on August 25, 2016.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.

5. The Director finds that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Rodriguez' Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 546921 issued to Rodriguez is REVOKED, effective immediately.

## NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

## NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).*

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
