**SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING  
IDAHO NONRESIDENT  
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice that the Wisconsin Commissioner of Insurance, Division of Market Regulation and Enforcement (“OCI”), has issued an *Order of Revocation* revoking the intermediary insurance license of Chelsey J. Killerlain (“Killerlain”). Upon reviewing the *Order of Revocation*, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order Revoking Killerlain’s Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 614087.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Killerlain, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed in her home state of Wisconsin as an intermediary (agent) individual with National Producer No. 18381832.
2. On May 6, 2022, the OCI issued an *Order of Revocation* in an administrative action against Killerlain, Case No. 22-C44437, revoking her Wisconsin intermediary insurance license upon finding that she violated Wisconsin law by failing to pay delinquent taxes. The *Order of Revocation* became a final order on or about June 6, 2022.
3. Killerlain has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 614087 since its issuance on April 21, 2017.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.

5. The Director finds these circumstances justify revoking Killerlain's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

## ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Killerlain's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 614087 is REVOKED, effective immediately.

The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:


- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
