SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice that, on July 18, 2022, the Utah Insurance Department (the "Utah Department") issued a *Notice of Agency Action and Order* revoking the resident producer individual insurance license of Robert L. Brogan ("Brogan"), effective August 2, 2022. Upon reviewing the *Notice of Agency Action and Order*, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order Revoking Brogan's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 900094.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Brogan, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed in his home state of Utah as an resident producer under individual insurance license No. 547888.
- 2. On July 18, 2022, the Utah Department issued a *Notice of Agency Action and Order* in Docket No. 2022-4411, revoking Brogan's resident producer individual insurance license because Brogan had violated Utah law by: (1) providing information on the license application that was incorrect and materially misleading; (2) failing to report criminal prosecution against him to the Utah Department within 30 days of the initial court appearance; (3) failing to pay state income tax or to

comply with an administrative or court order directing payment of state income tax; (4) failing to pay a final judgment rendered against Brogan in the state of Utah within 60 days after the day on which the judgment became final; (5) failing to meet the trustworthy character requirement; and (6) being unqualified for a license under Utah laws. The order became final on August 2, 2022.

3. Brogan has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 900094 since its issuance on December 15, 2021.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.
- 5. The Director finds these circumstances justify revoking Brogan's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

## **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Brogan's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No.900094 is REVOKED, effective immediately.

# NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

### NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
