SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING
IDAHO NONRESIDENT
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received a notice that the Commissioner of the Insurance Department of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania "(IDCP") accepted the voluntary surrender of Andre Cantre's ("Cantre") resident producer license to do the business of insurance in Pennsylvania.

For the reasons discussed below, the Director enters this Summary Order Revoking Cantre's Idaho Nonresident Producer License.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On, April 6, 2022, the IDCP issued Cantre a resident producer insurance agent license, number 20292506.
- 2. On or around June 5, 2023, the IDCP and Cantre entered into an agreement that Cantre would voluntarily surrender his resident producer license in lieu the IDCP taking regulatory and/or administrative action against him.
 - 3. On June 5, 2023, Cantre voluntarily surrendered his resident producer license to IDCP,

which was accepted. Based on his agreement with IDCP, for a period of three years, Cantre and can no longer perform any activities within Pennsylvania for which insurance licensure is required.

4. Cantre has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer since September 2, 2022.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Per Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for up to 12 months, or revoke or refuse to continue, any license issued to a nonresident under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, if the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue from the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state...
- 2. These circumstances justify revoking Cantre's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License under Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Cantre's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License is REVOKED, effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. Filing a petition for judicial review does not, by itself, stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
