SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice that, on April 5, 2024, the Commissioner of the Massachusetts Department of Insurance issued an *Order to Cease and Desist* requiring Brown & Brown of Massachusetts LLC ("Brown & Brown") to discontinue the engagement of any and all insurance business within the state of Massachusetts. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1016(1)(i) and 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Brown & Brown's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 16153243.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Brown & Brown, at all times relevant hereto, held a Massachusetts resident insurance producer license.
- 2. On April 5, 2024, the Commissioner of the Massachusetts Department of Insurance issued an *Order to Cease and Desist* requiring Brown & Brown to discontinue the engagement of any and all insurance business within the state of Massachusetts effective April 5, 2024.
- 3. Brown & Brown has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 16153243 since its issuance on July 18, 2019.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(1)(i) provides that the Director may impose an

administrative penalty or may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, for having a license suspended in any other state.

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.

6. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Brown & Brown's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1016(1)(i) and 41-1016(2)(a).

#### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 16153243 issued to Brown & Brown of Massachusetts LLC is REVOKED effective immediately;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Brown & Brown of Massachusetts LLC shall not reapply for an Idaho Resident Producer License, nor any other license issued under title 41, Idaho Code, for a period of five (5) years after the date of the Final Order.

for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by

operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order

or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court

of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the

parting seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or

(4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
