RE: *Preliminary Order Denying Application for Nonresident Producer License*  
Docket No. 18-4437-24

Dear Mr. Jordan:

The Idaho Department of Insurance (the "Department") has concluded its review of your Application for Nonresident Producer License received on or about May 7, 2024.

Idaho Code § 41-1016(1) authorizes the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (the "Director") to refuse to issue an insurance producer license to an applicant under the circumstances set forth in subsections (a) through (n) of that section. Subsection (a) of Idaho Code § 41-1016(1) provides that "providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application" establishes grounds for the Director to refuse to issue an insurance license.

Question 2 under Background Questions on the Application for Producer License asks: "Have you ever been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding, including FINRA sanction or arbitration proceeding regarding any professional or occupational license or registration?"

You answered no to that question; however, records and information reviewed by the Department reflect that your response was incorrect or untrue. Specifically, on or about March 1, 2024, a dispute was filed against you resulting in the revocation and restriction of your California nonresident insurance producer license. Your failure to respond affirmatively and disclose your involvement in a previous administrative proceeding constitutes "providing incorrect, misleading, [and] materially untrue information" on your license application and establishes grounds for denial of your application for an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license.

Based upon the foregoing, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(1)(a), the Director has determined that it is appropriate that your application for an Idaho nonresident producer license be and is hereby **denied**. This letter shall serve as the Director's preliminary order denying your license application.

### NOTICE OF RIGHTS

You have the right to request a hearing concerning the denial of your application for an Idaho resident producer license. Pursuant to § 41-232A(1), such request must be in writing and be received by the Department within twenty-one (21) days of the issuance of this preliminary order. Your failure to request a hearing within that time period shall be deemed a waiver of the opportunity for a hearing, and this order shall become a final order, as defined in the Idaho Administrative Procedure Act, Idaho Code § 67-5240 *et seq.* (IDAPA), without further notice. Any hearing held in this matter will be conducted in accordance with the contested case provisions of the IDAPA.

Should you decide to request a hearing in this matter, your request must be in writing, must be timely made, and pursuant to § 41-232(3), must summarize the information and grounds you intend to rely on as the basis for the relief you seek at the hearing. If properly and timely requested, a hearing will be held within thirty (30) days after receipt of your request, unless postponed by mutual consent.

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. As such, it is public record and is public information that may be disclosed to other states and reported to companies with which you are actively appointed. Be aware that you may be required to disclose this proceeding on any license application and to report it to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.


