**SUMMARY ORDER
REVOKING IDAHO
NONRESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice of the entry of an order by the Commissioner of the California Department of Insurance wherein David Malt’s (“Malt”) national producer license no. 2668467 was surrendered in the state of California. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1016(1)(i) and 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Malt’s Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 2668467.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Malt, at all times relevant hereto, held a California resident insurance producer license.
2. On July 26, 2024, the Commissioner of the California Department of Insurance issued an order wherein Malt’s resident insurance producer license was surrendered to the California Department of Insurance effective July 26, 2024.

3. Malt has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 2668467 since its issuance on March 7, 2023.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.
5. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Malt's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1016(1)(i) and 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 2668467 issued to David Malt is REVOKED effective immediately;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT David Malt shall not re-apply for an Idaho nonresident producer license, nor any other license issued under title 41, Idaho Code, for a period of five (5) years after the date of the Final Order.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).*


Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See Idaho Code § 67-5273.* The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
