**SUMMARY ORDER
REVOKING IDAHO
NONRESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice from the National Insurance Producer Registry (“NIPR”) wherein Alexandria Moore (“Moore”) was issued an Idaho nonresident producer license without making the appropriate payment of licensing fees. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1007(d) and 41-1016(1)(b), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Moore’s Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 7155867.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Moore, at all times relevant hereto, held a Florida resident insurance producer license.
2. Moore has been an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 7155867 since its issuance on October 13, 2023.
3. On October 13, 2023, Moore applied for an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license using the NIPR website and concurrently submitted an electronic payment

to NIPR for the application fees. The electronic payment was returned by Moore's financial institution as nonsufficient funds. Moore received an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license without making the appropriate payment.

4. On February 1, 2024, the Department sent a Letter of Demand for Nonsufficient Funds to Moore via email to the address used in the application. No response was received from Moore.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(1)(b) provides that the Director may impose an administrative penalty or may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, for violating any provision of title 41, Idaho Code, department rule, subpoena or order of the director or of another state's insurance director.
6. Idaho Administrative Code 18.01.02.030.01.b provides that an eighty-dollar (\$80) fee is due at the time of original application for a producer license.
7. Idaho Code § 41-1007(d) provides that any person applying for a resident insurance producer license shall make application to the director on the uniform application and the director shall find that the applicant has paid the fees prescribed by the director pursuant to § 41-401, Idaho Code.
8. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Moore's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 41-1016(1)(b) and 41-1007(d).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 7155867 issued to Alexandria Moore is REVOKED effective immediately;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Alexandria Moore shall not be issued a new nonresident producer license, or any other license issued under title 41, Idaho Code, until all delinquent fees have been paid to the National Insurance Producer Registry.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).*

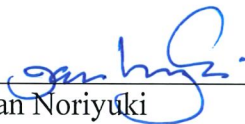
Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See Idaho Code § 67-5273.* The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *Idaho Code § 67-5274.*
