**SUMMARY ORDER
REVOKING IDAHO
NONRESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice from the National Insurance Producer Registry (“NIPR”) wherein DANA ABDULLAH (“Abdullah”) was issued an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license without making the appropriate payment of licensing fees. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1009(b), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Abdullah’s Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 21357741.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Abdullah, at all times relevant hereto, held a Florida resident insurance producer license.
2. Abdullah has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 21357741 since its issuance on October 18, 2024.
3. On October 18, 2024, Abdullah applied for an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license using the NIPR website and concurrently submitted an electronic payment to NIPR for the application fees. The electronic payment was returned by

Abdullah's financial institution as nonsufficient funds. Abdullah received an Idaho nonresident insurance producer license without making the appropriate payment.

4. On March 3, 2025, the Department sent a Letter of Demand for Nonsufficient Funds to Abdullah via email to the address used in the application. No response was received from Abdullah.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Idaho Administrative Code 18.01.02.030.01.b provides that an eighty-dollar (\$80) fee is due at the time of original application for a producer license.
6. Idaho Code § 41-1009(b) provides that a nonresident applicant shall receive a nonresident producer license if the applicant has submitted the proper request for licensure and has paid the fees set forth by rule pursuant to section 41-401, Idaho Code.
7. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Abdullah's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1009(b).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 21357741 issued to DANA ABDULLAH is REVOKED effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DANA ABDULLAH shall not be issued a new Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, or any other license issued under Title 41, Idaho Code, until all delinquent fees have been paid to the National Insurance Producer Registry.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).*

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order; (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See Idaho Code § 67-5273.* The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *See Idaho Code § 67-5274.*
