Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 9025325 SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice of the entry of an order by the Texas Department of Insurance wherein MACEDONIO JOHN MARTINEZ's ("Martinez") resident producer license number 9025325 was revoked in the state of Texas. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Martinez's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 9025325.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Martinez, at all times relevant hereto, held a Texas resident insurance producer license.
- 2. On May 20, 2025, the Texas Department of Insurance issued an order wherein Martinez's resident insurance producer license was revoked in the state of Texas effective May 20, 2025.
- 3. Martinez has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 9025325 since its issuance on July 15, 2022.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.
- 5. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Martinez's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 9025325 issued to MACEDONIO JOHN MARTINEZ is REVOKED effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order; (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5274.
