ORDER OF DEFAULT

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) having reviewed the record herein; and Stephen Neu (“Neu”) who currently holds Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 1258380, having been lawfully served the Verified Complaint and Notice of Right to Hearing (“Complaint”), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, and, as evident from the Affidavit of Matt Steen, having failed to file an answer thereto and having failed to request a hearing regarding said Complaint; and the Director having found as a result thereof

that Neu is in default and has waived his rights regarding the opportunity for hearing; an in consideration of the above;

It is hereby ordered that Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 1258380 issued to Stephen Neu is revoked effective immediately.

It is further ordered that Neu shall pay to the Idaho Department of Insurance an administrative penalty of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order; (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not in itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5274.

**VERIFIED COMPLAINT
AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO
HEARING**

COMES NOW the staff of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its undersigned counsel, Matt K. Steen, Deputy Attorney General, and does hereby give notice of verified allegations constituting violation(s) of Idaho law, notice that relief will be requested from the Director of the Department, and a notice of the right to contest the allegations and requested relief herein and right to hearing to:

STEPHEN NEU
Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 1258380

The Department alleges the following facts and violations of title 41, Idaho Code, as itemized below. The Department will present an order seeking the relief described below upon twenty-one (21) days following service of this Verified Complaint, and STEPHEN NEU is further notified of his right to object to the requested relief, including the basis for any objection, and to request a hearing in writing.

JURISDICTION

1. Jurisdiction in this matter is founded in the Idaho Insurance Code, Idaho Code § 41-101 *et seq.*, including Idaho Code § 41-210, which authorizes the Director of the Department of Insurance (“Director”) to enforce the provisions of title 41 of the Idaho Code, including those governing Respondent’s activities as an insurance producer.

2. Jurisdiction is further founded in Idaho Code § 41-213, which authorizes the Department to institute such proceedings as deemed necessary for the enforcement of any provision of the Idaho Insurance Code including, but not limited to, license revocation and the imposition of administrative penalties.

CONTROLLING LAW

3. Section 41-1016(1), Idaho Code, provides that the Director may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a producer’s license and may impose an administrative penalty up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000), if the Director finds that any of the causes or violations set forth in subsections 41-1016(1)(a) through (o) exist, including, but not limited to subsections (b) and (i), for:

(b) violating any provision of title 41, Idaho Code, department rule, subpoena or order of the director of another state’s insurance director;

- (i) having an insurance license denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

4. Section 41-1021(1), Idaho Code, states a producer shall report to the director any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency within thirty (30) days of the final disposition of the matter.

5. Section 41-117, Idaho Code, provides that each instance of violation may be considered a separate offense.

RESPONDENT

6. STEPHEN NEU (hereinafter “Neu” or “Respondent Neu”) is a Texas resident and holds active Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 1258380, which was originally issued on October 22, 2018.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

COUNT I

7. All of the foregoing paragraphs are re-alleged and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

8. On June 3, 2025, the Kansas Department of Insurance issued an Order of Revocation of Neu’s license for failure to respond to an inquiry of the Commissioner of the Kansas Department of Insurance. On July 3, 2025, The Department received a RIRS notice of the action.

9. On July 9, 2025, Lori Thomason of the Department attempted to contact Neu via telephone and email to remind him of his obligation to report the actions.

10. As of this date, Neu has not reported the action to the Department.

11. The Department alleges that the actions against Mr. Neu in Kansas justify revocation of his Idaho nonresident license pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(i).

12. The Department alleges that Neu also violated Idaho Code § 41-1021 by failing to

notify the Department of the administrative action by the Kansas Department of Insurance within thirty (30) days.

13. Based on the allegations noted herein, the Department is seeking an Order imposing an administrative penalty against Respondent Neu in the amount of \$1,000 per violation, for a total of \$2,000.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Based on the foregoing facts as alleged, the Department prays for relief as follows:

1. For an Order revoking STEPHEN NEU's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 1258380.
2. For an Order that, in the event STEPHEN NEU files an application for any license under title 41, Idaho Code, STEPHEN NEU must first petition and show good cause why the prior revocation should not be deemed a bar to the issuance of a new license.
3. For and Order imposing an administrative penalty against STEPHEN NEU in the amount of \$1,000 per violation, for a total of \$2,000.00 for the violations alleged in Count I.
4. In the event of default in this action, the Department asks for an award of not less than \$2,000.

For such other and further relief as the Director deems just and necessary under the circumstances.

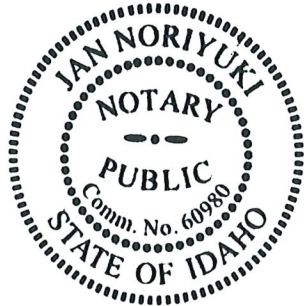

Failure to file and serve a written request for a hearing upon the Department within the 21-day time period shall be deemed a waiver of the opportunity for a hearing and to contest the allegations in the Complaint, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-232A(2). If you fail to submit a timely written response to the allegations within 21 days of the service of this Complaint, a final order will be entered imposing the relief described above.


