**SUMMARY ORDER
REVOKING IDAHO
NONRESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice of the entry of an order by the Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of Insurance Agent and Agency Services wherein HECTOR ANDRES MATUTE’s (“Matute”) resident producer license number 20862271 was surrendered in the state of Florida. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Matute’s Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License Number 20862271.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Matute, at all times relevant hereto, held a Florida resident insurance producer license.
2. On December 30, 2024, the Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of Insurance Agent and Agency Services issued a Consent Order wherein Matute agreed to retest for licensure in Florida and provide proof of a passing score within 30 days of the entry of the Order.

Further stated in the Consent Order, if Matute failed to pass every reexamination within the 30-day period, all licenses would be surrendered in Florida.

3. According to records maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners, Matute's resident producer license in his home state of Florida became inactive on February 22, 2025.

4. Matute has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 20862271 since its issuance on September 4, 2024.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.

6. The Director finds that the loss of Matute's resident license for failure to comply with Florida's Consent Order constitutes a "refusal to continue" by the Florida Department of Financial Services for purposes of Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

7. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Matute's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 20862271 issued to HECTOR ANDRES MATUTE is REVOKED effective immediately.

NOTICE REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).*


Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) the service of an order denying the motion for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See Idaho Code § 67-5273.* The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *See Idaho Code § 67-5274.*
