SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NON-RESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) has received notice of the entry of an order by the Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas suspending the Arkansas resident insurance producer license issued to BRADLEY NEAL THOMAS (THOMAS), as further described below. Upon review of such order, and, pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. THOMAS, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of Arkansas.

- 2. On or about January 28, 2015, the Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas entered a Consent Order, identified as A.I.D. No. 2015-012, based on the licensee's demonstration of "incompetence, untrustworthiness, lack of good personal or business reputation, or financial irresponsibility." Such order suspended the Arkansas resident insurance producer license issued to THOMAS, for a period of one year, whereupon THOMAS' license shall be reinstated on probationary status for a period of two years.
- 3. Such Consent Order also revoked the Arkansas producer agency license of Thomas & Associates Agency, Inc., of which THOMAS is President. Thomas & Associates Agency, Inc., does not hold an Idaho insurance license.
- 4. THOMAS has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident insurance producer, holding license number 133048 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on January 20, 2006, to the present date.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of THOMAS' Idaho non-resident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License No. 133048 issued to THOMAS is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that THOMAS shall immediately return Idaho Non-resident Insurance Producer License No. 133048 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal this order by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of (a) the service date of this final order, (b) an order denying petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21)

days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
