ORDER TERMINATING DEVIATION FROM 2015 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES AND PERMITTING DEVIATION FROM 2016 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATES

AMERICAN FAMILY INSURANCE COMPANY (AMERICAN FAMILY), is an Ohiodomiciled insurer licensed to transact workers' compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 4293 and is a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI).

On June 23, 2015, in accordance with AMERICAN FAMILY's request, the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) issued an order in Docket No. 18-3065-15, authorizing AMERICAN FAMILY to deviate from the workers' compensation rates filed by the

NCCI for 2015. Pursuant to such order, the 2015 rate deviation became effective on September 1, 2015, and was to remain in effect for one year, *i.e.*, until August 31, 2016, unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.

On or about October 29, 2015, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) received from AMERICAN FAMILY a request for permission to withdraw the rate deviation authorized by the Director's order in Docket No. 18-3065-15, effective December 31, 2015, and to deviate from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2016 by a uniform percentage decrease of fifteen percent (15%), effective January 1, 2016.

AMERICAN FAMILY and the NCCI have each indicated in writing that they do not request a hearing on this matter.

The Department's Director (Director), having reviewed and being fully apprised of AMERICAN FAMILY's request and of the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1614, has determined that the request is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that AMERICAN FAMILY's current rate deviation, as authorized by the Director's order in Docket No. 18-3065-15, shall terminate effective at midnight on December 31, 2015.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614, that AMERICAN FAMILY's request to deviate by a uniform percentage decrease of fifteen percent (15%) from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2016, exclusive of terrorism rates, is GRANTED. This deviation from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2016 shall take effect on January 1, 2016, and shall remain in effect for one year from that date unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.
