ORDER PERMITTING DEVIATION FROM 2017 WORKERS' COMPENSATION RATING VALUES

SENTRY CASUALTY COMPANY (SENTRY) is a Wisconsin-domiciled insurer licensed to transact workers' compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 3574 and is a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI).

On or about November 16, 2016, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) received from SENTRY a request for permission to deviate from the workers' compensation rating values filed by the NCCI for 2017, by applying a rate of \$0.00 (no charge) for Catastrophe (other than Certified Acts of Terrorism) coverage associated with its Idaho workers' compensation coverage, which rate represents a negative one hundred percent (-100%) deviation,

and by applying a rate of \$0.01 for Terrorism coverage associated with its Idaho workers'

compensation coverage, which rate represents a negative fifty percent (-50%) deviation.

SENTRY and the NCCI have each waived the right to a hearing on the deviation request.

The Department's Director (Director), having reviewed and being fully apprised of

SENTRY's request to deviate from the Idaho workers' compensation rating values filed by the

NCCI for 2017 as set forth above, and after considering the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-

1614, has determined that the requested rate deviation is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614,

that SENTRY's request to deviate from the workers' compensation rating values filed by the

NCCI for 2017, by applying a rate of \$0.00 (no charge) for Catastrophe (other than Certified

Acts of Terrorism) coverage associated with its Idaho workers' compensation coverage, which

rate represents a negative one hundred percent (-100%) deviation, and by applying a rate of

\$0.01 for Terrorism coverage associated with its Idaho workers' compensation coverage, which

rate represents a negative fifty percent (-50%) deviation, is GRANTED. This deviation from the

Idaho workers' compensation rating values filed by the NCCI for 2017 shall take effect on

January 1, 2017, and shall remain in effect for one year from that date unless terminated sooner

with the approval of the Director.
