ORDER AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL FROM MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT MARKET

On August 30, 2017, the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Department") received notice of the intent of GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY ("GPM Life") to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho, effective October 1, 2017, by discontinuing the availability of its Medicare Supplement plans, which are identified as policy forms: MTP20-23597 (Plan A); MTP22-23598 (Plan C); MTP24-23599 (Plan F); MTP25-23600 (Plan G); and MTP31-23601 (Plan N).

GPM Life acknowledged that its withdrawal of Medicare Supplement policies from sale in Idaho will prohibit GPM Life from filing for approval in Idaho a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare Supplement benefit plans as the

discontinued forms for a period of five (5) years from the date of GPM Life's notice to the Department, pursuant to the requirements of IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b. GPM Life represented that it will continue to service its existing in-force Medicare Supplement policies covering Idaho insureds.

GPM Life's notice of intent to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho appears to comply with the notice requirements to the Department's Director (Director) as set forth in IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a.

The Director, having reviewed the foregoing and the requirements of IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04, and good cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.a, that GPM Life is authorized to withdraw from the Medicare Supplement market in Idaho, effective October 1, 2017.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to IDAPA 18.01.54.030.04.b, that GPM Life shall not file with the Department a new policy form or certificate form of the same type for the same standard Medicare Supplement benefit plans as the discontinued forms prior to August 30, 2022.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This Order constitutes a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The Director will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See*, Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See, Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
