SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director"), having been apprised of the voluntary surrender of the North Carolina resident insurance producer license of ALPHONSO WEBB ("WEBB"), as further described below, and pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. According to records maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners and by the North Carolina Department of Insurance, WEBB was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of North Carolina, from the issuance of such license on September 21, 2012, until the license was voluntarily surrendered by WEBB effective May 5, 2018.

- 2. The Department has not received notification from WEBB of relicensing as a resident in any other state.
- 3. WEBB has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer, holding license number 429339 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on October 29, 2012, to the present date.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any nonresident insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the nonresident no longer has a license in the licensee's home state because the home state license was "[v]oluntarily surrendered for any reason except relicensing as a resident in another state."
- 5. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of WEBB's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i).

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 429339 issued to WEBB is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(1), that WEBB shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 429339 to the Idaho

Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

## NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. Be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any license application and must be reported to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

### **NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS**

This is a final order of the Director. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal this order by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

i. A hearing was held,

- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of (a) the service date of this final order, (b) an order denying petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
