SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice of the Mississippi Insurance Department's refusal to continue the resident insurance producer license of DUSTIN MICHAEL BLOUNT ("BLOUNT"), as further described below. Upon review of such notice, and, pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

 BLOUNT, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of Mississippi.

- 2. On or about April 5, 2019, the Mississippi Insurance Department issued a Notice of Denial, denying BLOUNT's application for renewal of his resident producer license. Such denial was based on BLOUNT's failure to disclose in the renewal application that he was under a criminal indictment issued in June 2018 charging him with false pretense, insurance fraud, fraud and wire fraud.
- 3. BLOUNT has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer, holding license number 661900 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on March 30, 2018, to the present date.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of BLOUNT's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 661900 issued to BLOUNT is hereby REVOKED effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(1), that BLOUNT shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 661900 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;

- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
