SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director), having been apprised of the voluntary surrender of the North Carolina resident insurance producer license of ROLAND MEDINA ("MEDINA"), as further described below, and pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. According to records maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners and by the North Carolina Department of Insurance, MEDINA was licensed as a resident insurance producer in the state of North Carolina from the issuance of such license on December 6, 2016, until the license was voluntarily surrendered by MEDINA for a period of twenty (20) years, effective April 24, 2020, in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 58-2-65, which provides for surrender of a license by a licensee accused of any act, omission, or misconduct that would subject the license to suspension or revocation.
 - 2. MEDINA has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance

producer, holding license number 598777 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on December 9, 2016, to the present date.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any nonresident insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the nonresident no longer has a license in the licensee's home state because the home state license was "[v]oluntarily surrendered for any reason except relicensing as a resident in another state."

4. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of MEDINA's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 598777 issued to MEDINA is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(1), that MEDINA shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 598777 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business

in Idaho; or

iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
