ORDER AUTHORIZING BLOCK NONRENEWAL

On or about November 4, 2020, American Modern Insurance Group, Inc. ("American Modern Group"), an insurance holding company that includes AMERICAN MODERN SELECT INSURANCE COMPANY, AMERICAN MODERN HOME INSURANCE COMPANY, and AMERICAN FAMILY HOME INSURANCE COMPANY (collectively, "the Companies"), provided to the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Department") written notification of the Companies' intent to block nonrenew in-force dwelling fire, mobile home, watercraft, and renters insurance policies delivered or issued for delivery in Idaho. American Modern Group represented

that the contemplated block nonrenewal will affect approximately one thousand three hundred ninety-three (1,393) policies covering Idaho insureds, allocated among the Companies as follows:

American Modern Group further represented that affected policies will be nonrenewed at their natural expiration, beginning no sooner than March 4, 2021.

The Director of the Department, having reviewed the foregoing and the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1841(1), and acting pursuant to the authority set forth in Idaho Code § 41-210(2),

THE DIRECTOR HEREBY FINDS that the proposed effective date of the contemplated block nonrenewal complies with the one hundred twenty (120) day notice requirement to the Director, as set forth in Idaho Code § 41-1841(1).

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Companies are authorized, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1841, to effectuate a block nonrenewal of their dwelling fire, mobile home, watercraft, and renters insurance policies delivered or issued for delivery in Idaho, which, based on representations made to the Department, will affect approximately one thousand three hundred ninety-three (1,393) policies covering Idaho insureds as set forth above. The Companies shall begin nonrenewing affected policies at each policy's natural expiration date beginning no

sooner than March 4, 2021. The Companies shall provide advance notice to policyholders affected by the nonrenewals authorized by this order in accordance with Idaho law and with the notice provisions included in the company's applicable insurance policies.

THIS ORDER is a final order of the Director and is EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
