SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director"), has received notice of the entry of an order by the Wisconsin Insurance Commissioner suspending the Wisconsin resident insurance license issued to DIANNE-LYNN McLESTER-HEIM ("McLESTER-HEIM"), as further described below. Upon review of such order, and pursuant to the authority granted by Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director does hereby make the following findings and enter a Summary Order as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. McLESTER-HEIM, at all times relevant hereto, held a Wisconsin resident insurance license.
- 2. On or about March 3, 2021, the Wisconsin Insurance Commissioner issued an order in File No. 21-C43915, suspending the Wisconsin resident insurance license issued to McLESTER-HEIM, based on findings that McLESTER-HEIM was indicted on December 15, 2020, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Wisconsin, Green Bay Division, on charges of stealing, embezzling, and converting medical reimbursement claims.
 - 3. McLESTER-HEIM has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident

insurance producer, holding license number 805293 from the date of the initial issuance of such license on October 13, 2020, to the present date.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state. Based on the foregoing, the Director finds that the circumstances set forth above justify the revocation of McLESTER-HEIM's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 805293 issued to McLESTER-HEIM is hereby REVOKED, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(1), that McLESTER-HEIM shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 805293 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: 700 West State Street, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;

- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
