DEFINITION OF TRAVEL LIMITED LINES

• Travel insurance is designed to cover the costs and reduce the risk associated with unexpected events during domestic or international travel. It usually covers the insured in two main categories: costs associated with travel-related medical expenses and trip cancellations.

THE LICENSE

- This license is the property of the State of Idaho and issued to the producer, who is responsible for its safekeeping.
- In the event this license is cancelled, surrendered, terminated, revoked or suspended, it is your responsibility to provide a <u>Dissolution of License Affidavit</u>.

ADDRESS CHANGES

- Per §41-1008 (6), all producers must inform the Department of Insurance *within 30 days* of any change of address.
- Please complete a <u>Business Entity Change of Address Form</u> and fax any change of address, phone or fax to 208-334-4398 as NIPR does not process business entity changes of address.
- Email changes can be reported here.

LICENSE RENEWALS

- Licenses are issued for 2 years. Agency licenses expire on the first day of month following issuance. You are responsible for the timely renewal of your license. You will receive a courtesy "notice to renew" approximately 6 weeks prior to your renewal date. You do not need to receive this notice in order to renew your license. Please go to www.nipr.com or www.sircon.com to renew online or to www.doi.idaho.gov to renew by paper anytime within the 6-week period prior to expiration.
- Your renewal fee must be received or postmarked prior to your expiration date to avoid paying a late fee. Resident entities renewing past the expiration date will need to get the appropriate reinstatement form from our website and send in with the appropriate fees. Non-residents may reinstate online.
- NOTE: Appointments/registrations are terminated once a license is lapsed and will need to be resubmitted when the license is reactivated.

COMPANY APPOINTMENTS

- A carrier appointment is required prior to doing business.
- Appointments can be processed electronically through NIPR or Sircon.

DBA'S (ASSUMED BUSINESS NAMES):

- When using a name other than your legal name, the Idaho Department of Insurance requires the "Doing Business As" or "Assumed Business Name" be filed with the Idaho Secretary of State, per §30-21-801 through §30-21-810.
- Per **§41-1014**, the SOS filed name must also be filed with the Idaho Department of Insurance using our approved form.
- If this name is incorporated (INC, LLC, LLP), it must be licensed as an insurance producer.

- Only names filed or licensed with the Department of Insurance may be used to conduct insurance transactions.

REPORTING OF ACTIONS

- Producers have a duty to report any criminal or administrative actions to the Idaho Department of Insurance within 30 days per §41-1021,
- We encourage use of the **NIPR Reporting of Actions Warehouse** at www.nipr.com as a convenient means to post your documents and explanations.
- You will be able to report to us and any other state in which you are licensed in a single transaction.

ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE LICENSE

Annually, no later than March 1st, the Wholesaler licensed for Travel Limited Line must report Idaho premiums and any updates to retail outlets covered under their license authority using the online portal found on the Limited Lines page.
