How to Apply for a Bail Agency License

Note: Non-resident Bail Agencies must have the equivalent license and lines of authority they are applying for in Idaho in their home state.

Step 1: Register the agency with the <u>Idaho Secretary of State</u> at sos.idaho.gov

Note: Non-resident (foreign) entities must use the Director of The Department of Insurance (Dean Cameron) as their service of process when registering the business entity.



Step 2: Have at least one designated responsible licensed producer (DRLP) lined for the agency. A Designated Responsible Licensed Producer is an individual responsible for the agency 's compliance with the insurance laws and rules of this state.

Step 3: Obtain an **Appointment** to a Surety company.

Step 4: Acquire a bond in the amount of \$15,000. The bond must be on the DOI's bond form.

Step 5: Go to NIPR.com and submit a new license application.
