

FINDING A CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE

1. From our [web page](#) click on "Course Catalog".

2. Select Idaho from the drop down menu and "Course or Provider" from the second . The page will change. Click " I agree to the NAIC's Terms and Conditions" then "Search".

You can leave everything in this section blank. The search screen on the next page is cleaner and easier to use.

4. Click on the course name of the one you wish to take.

Helpful Tips:

- **Provider and Course names** must be exact. If there is an extra space or a misspelling it will return no results.
- **Education Type** can be ignored as Idaho does not require pre-licensing education.
- **Course Method** is how you want to take the course. In person options are classroom and Seminar, all other methods can be done online.
- **Course Group** is what the course covers. All LOA and several combinations are available. The only one required for all licensees is Ethics. For more details on courses required for your license visit the [Department of Insurance's website](#) dedicated to your license type.
- **Offering Location Criteria** is only valid for in person courses.

5. Contact the provider to sign up for the course.

Notes: Do not contact the Idaho Department of Insurance about specific courses. Please reach out directly to the CE provider for additional information, including instructions for how to enroll. All self study type courses will show "No results found." under Course Offerings, as there is no set schedule.
