SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice that, on May 23, 2022, the Director of the Florida Division of Insurance Agent and Agency Services issued a *Settlement Stipulation for Consent Order* and *Consent Order* that suspended Andres J. Suarez' ("Suarez") licenses to conduct the business of insurance in Florida for 24 months. Upon reviewing the order, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order Revoking Suarez' Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 584623.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Suarez, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed in his home state of Florida as a resident life, variable annuity and resident health insurance agent under license number W225589.
- 2. On May 20, 2022, the State of Florida Department of Financial Services, Suarez and licensee Roberto J. Pancorbo, Jr., in Case Nos. 279066-21-AG and 282768-21-AG, entered into a *Settlement Stipulation for Consent Order* in which the parties agreed, among other things,

that Pancorbo's and Suarez' Florida licenses would be suspended for 24 months commencing August 1, 2022. The underlying facts, per the stipulation, were as follows. In summary, Pancorbo and Suarez agreed they owned and managed Great Health Choice, LLC, that they have held appointments with Mutual of Omaha Life Insurance Company, and that they submitted an appointment application for Barbara Dolan. They also agreed that the application purportedly was signed by Dolan but the signature was not genuine. Further, the application directed Mutual of Omaha to deposit Dolan's commissions into a bank account which Pancorbo and Suarez were signatories, but Dolan was not, which precluded Dolan from receiving commissions. Pancorbo and Suarez agreed they subsequently received \$152,940.47 in commissions from Mutual of Omaha.

- 3. On May 23, 2022, the Director of the Florida Division of Insurance Agent & Agency Services signed a *Consent Order* that approved and incorporated the stipulation by reference and suspended Pancorbo's and Suarez' licenses for twenty-four months commencing August 1, 2022.
- 4. Suarez has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 584623 since its issuance on August 25, 2016.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.
- 5. The Director finds that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Suarez' Idaho nonresident insurance producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 584623 issued to Suarez is REVOKED effective immediately.

The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or

located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
