**SUMMARY ORDER
REVOKING IDAHO
NON-RESIDENT INSURANCE
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) has received notice of an administrative action by the Ohio Department of Insurance (“Ohio”) wherein DOMINIC BIRTHA’s (“Birtha”) resident producer license number 21733907 was voluntarily surrendered for cause in the state of Ohio. For the reasons discussed below and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking Birtha’s Idaho Non-Resident Producer License No. 21733907.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Birtha, at all times relevant hereto, held an Ohio resident producer license.
2. On January 6, 2026, the Ohio Department of Insurance accepted the voluntary surrender for cause of Birtha’s Ohio resident producer license in lieu of license suspension or revocation in the state of Ohio effective January 6, 2026.

3. Birtha has been licensed as an Idaho non-resident producer under license number 21733907 since its issuance on November 24, 2025.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the non-resident no longer has a license in the licensee's home state because the home state license was voluntarily surrendered for any reason except relicensing as a resident in another state.

5. The Director concludes that the above circumstances justify the revocation of Birtha's Idaho non-resident producer license, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(i).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Non-Resident Insurance Producer License No. 21733907 issued to DOMINIC BIRTHA is REVOKED effective immediately.

NOTICE REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

Be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any license application and must be reported to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) a hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the party seeking review of the order resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order; or (b) the service of an order denying the motion for reconsideration; or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5274.
