**STIPULATION AND ORDER**

**STIPULATION**

COME NOW the staff of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department), by and through its undersigned employee and counsel, and Steven R. Mechanic (Mechanic) and The Mechanic Group, Inc. (the Group) and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Mechanic holds non-resident producer license number 86955 and is therefore subject to the provisions of Title 41, Idaho Code, and to the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Insurance promulgated thereunder.

2. The Group holds non-resident producer license number 86954 and is therefore subject to the provisions of Title 41, Idaho Code, and to the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Insurance promulgated thereunder.

2. The Department received notification from the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) Regulatory Information Retrieval System (RIRS) that Mechanic and the Group had been subjects of administrative proceedings in the states of Kansas, New York and Rhode Island.


3. Mechanic and the Group admit to violating Idaho Code § 41-1021(1) by failing to report administrative proceedings to the Department within thirty (30) days.

4. Mechanic and the Group agree to pay an administrative penalty in the total amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).




