The Director of the Department of Insurance (“Department”) of the State of Idaho, having read and being fully apprised of the AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY (“Petitioner”) request for permission to block non-renew all of its personal umbrella coverages in Idaho known as Mass-Marketed Personal Umbrella policies; and Petitioner, having made its request to the Director of the Department by letter dated November 12, 2008, and in light of Idaho Code § 41-1841 and good cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Petitioner is allowed, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1841, to effectuate a block non-renewal of its Mass-Marketed Personal Umbrella policies in Idaho (consisting of Ten (10) policies) beginning on its intended date of May 30, 2009, but in any event, no sooner than One Hundred Twenty (120) days from its November 12, 2008 request, which is March 12, 2009. The Petitioner is to provide reasonable notice to policyholders affected

by the non-renewals allowed by this order in accordance with the policies. This order is a final order and is effective immediately. The prior order dated and filed January 28, 2009 is amended and superseded by this order.

### NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS


This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Section 67-5246(4), Idaho Code.

Pursuant to Sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal this final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days (a) of the service date of this final order, (b) of an order denying petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.


