WHEREAS, HECTOR ERNESTO MENDOZA (“MENDOZA”), is a duly licensed non-resident insurance producer in the state of Idaho, holding producer license No. 280756 and is therefore subject to the provisions of Title 41, Idaho Code, and to the rules of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Department”) promulgated thereunder; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2008 and effective September 18, 2008, the Department of Insurance, state of California (“California”), MENDOZA’s resident state, issued an order revoking MENDOZA’s license, File No. LBB 4786-AP (AR), based on allegations of a plea of nolo contendere to a felony.

WHEREAS, the California order constitutes grounds pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) to revoke MENDOZA's Idaho non-resident producer license No. 280756 without hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

That based on the foregoing, the non-resident producer license of HECTOR ERNESTO MENDOZA is hereby REVOKED pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2); and MENDOZA is hereby ordered to return his non-resident license No. 280756 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at 700 West State St., 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Boise, Idaho 83720 upon receipt of this executed order.

#### **NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS**


This constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates their principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located.

An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273.

The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.


