**STIPULATION**


COMES NOW the Department of Insurance, State of Idaho ("Department"), by and through its counsel, Mitchell E. Toryanski, Deputy Attorney General, and the Company Activities Bureau Chief, Georgia Siehl, and REGENCE BLUE SHIELD OF IDAHO, INC. ("RBSI"), by and through its undersigned authorized representative and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. RBSI, an Idaho corporation, is duly authorized as an insurer by the State of Idaho, holding certificate of authority number 1903 and is therefore subject to the provisions


of Title 41, Idaho Code, and to the Rules and Regulations of the Department promulgated thereunder. RBSI holds NAIC number 60131.


