

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The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (hereinafter the "Director"), having received an Order from the commonwealth of Virginia State Corporation Commission wherein the Virginia license of JEANETTE G. DESRUISSEAU was revoked and, upon further review, having verified the same, does hereby make the following findings and enters a Summary Order as follows:

1. That JEANETTE G. DESRUISSEAU (hereinafter "DESRUISSEAU"), whose address is 6137 Edwards St. Apt. 203, Norfolk, Virginia, 23513-1575, was licensed in the commonwealth of Virginia as a producer and that an Order

had been entered on or about November 4, 2009, by the State Insurance Commission of the commonwealth of Virginia effectively revoking DESRUISSEAU's Virginia producer license immediately.

2. That the Director obtained a copy of that revocation order on or about December 11, 2009.
3. That DESRUISSEAU has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident producer since the date of initial issue license on May 28, 2008. The license number, as identified above, is No. 287272.
4. That pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance shall suspend or revoke any license issued under Title 41, Chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of revocation from the insurance regulatory official of the licensee's home state.
5. Therefore, based upon the foregoing, the Director finds that a revocation of the license herein is appropriate, and, in consideration of the premises:

IT IS ORDERED that JEANETTE G. DESRUISSEAU's Idaho non-resident producer license No. 287272 is hereby REVOKED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that JEANETTE G. DESRUISSEAU shall immediately surrender and return her non-resident producer license No. 287272 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: Idaho Department of Insurance, 700 West State Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.

### NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273.

The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.


