

in the state of Utah as a producer and that a Default Order was entered on or about July 8, 2009, by the Utah State Insurance Department effectively revoking CLEMENTS' Utah producer license immediately.

2. That the Director obtained a copy of that revocation order on or about February 3, 2010.
3. That CLEMENTS has been continuously licensed as an Idaho non-resident producer since the date of initial issue of license on February 29, 2008. The license number, as identified above, is No. 279377.
4. That pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2) the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance shall suspend or revoke any license issued under Title 41, Chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of revocation from the insurance regulatory official of the licensee's home state.
5. Therefore, based upon the foregoing, the Director finds that a revocation of the license herein is appropriate, and, in consideration of the premises:

IT IS ORDERED that CYNTHIA CLEMENTS' Idaho non-resident producer license No. 279377 is hereby REVOKED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that CYNTHIA CLEMENTS shall immediately surrender and return her non-resident producer license No. 279377 to the Idaho Department of Insurance at the following address: Idaho Department of Insurance, 700 West State Street, 3rd Floor, Boise, Idaho, 83720-0043.



NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273.

The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.


