ORDER OF DEFAULT

The Director of the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Director), having reviewed the record on file herein; and it appearing therefrom that LAWRENCE REID BLACKBURN, the Respondent herein, has been duly served with a copy of the Complaint filed on January 26, 2012 by the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance (Department) in this administrative enforcement proceeding, which Complaint alleged violations of the Idaho Insurance Code by the Respondent; and further, as shown by the Affidavit of A. René Martin, Deputy Attorney General,

on file in this proceeding, that the Respondent has failed to request a hearing or otherwise dispute in writing the allegations set forth in such Complaint; and good cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Resident Producer License No. 107117, issued to LAWRENCE REID BLACKBURN, is HEREBY REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that LAWRENCE REID BLACKBURN shall immediately return Resident Producer License No. 107117 to the State of Idaho, Department of Insurance, at P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho 83720-0043;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an administrative penalty in the total amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000), constituting a penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each count alleged in the Complaint, be imposed on LAWRENCE REID BLACKBURN for his violations of the Idaho Insurance Code, which amount is due and payable to the Department immediately upon the entry of this Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

The foregoing is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. As such, it is a public record and is public information that may be disclosed to other states and reported to companies as to which you are actively appointed. This information will be reported to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) and will appear in the online

searchable database of the Idaho Department of Insurance. Be aware that this proceeding must be disclosed on any insurance license application and must be reported to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This Order constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this Final Order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).


Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.
