SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (Director) has been apprised that LUKE JAMES LUTGEN's Missouri resident insurance producer license has lapsed. Accordingly, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2), the Director enters this Summary Order revoking LUTGEN's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 555711.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. According to records maintained by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners and by the Missouri Department of Commerce and Insurance, LUTGEN was licensed as a resident insurance producer in his home state of Missouri until his license lapsed on March 6, 2021, due to nonrenewal.
- 2. The Director has not received notification that LUTGEN has been relicensed as a resident in any other state.
- 3. LUTGEN has been continuously licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 555711 since December 16, 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(ii) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than twelve (12) months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any nonresident insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the nonresident no longer has a license in the licensee's home state because the home state license was "nonrenewed by the nonresident and remains nonrenewed for a period greater than ninety (90) days beyond its expiration date, and without notice to the director of relicensing as a resident in another state."

5. The Director finds these circumstances justify the revocation of LUTGEN's Idaho nonresident insurance producer license under Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(b)(ii).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 555711 issued to LUTGEN is REVOKED, effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;

- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
