SUMMARY ORDER SUSPENDING IDAHO NONRESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance ("Director") has received notice that the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") has issued a *Findings of Fact and Suspension Order*, suspending the license of Merriel E. Milam ("Milam").

Upon reviewing the *Findings of Fact and Suspension Order*, and pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a), the Director enters this Summary Order Suspending Milam's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 603943.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Milam, at all times relevant hereto, was licensed in her home state of Indiana as a resident insurance producer under Indiana license number 320700.
- 2. On September 16, 2021, the Commissioner issued a *Findings of Fact and Suspension Order* in Case No. 20514-AG21-0902-171, which found that Milam violated Indiana law by failing to provide a list of appointments within ten (10) days of receiving the Commissioner's request. The order was a final order that immediately suspended Milam's Indiana resident insurance producer license until Milam submits the list of appointments requested by the Commissioner.

3. Milam has been licensed as an Idaho nonresident insurance producer under license number 603943 since its issuance on January 30, 2017.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 4. Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a) provides that the Director shall, without hearing, suspend for not more than 12 months, or shall revoke or refuse to continue any insurance producer license issued under title 41, chapter 10, Idaho Code, where the Director has received a final order of suspension, revocation, or refusal to continue issued by the insurance regulatory official or court of jurisdiction of the licensee's home state.
- 5. The Director finds these circumstances justify suspending Milam's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1016(2)(a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Milam's Idaho Nonresident Insurance Producer License No. 603943 is REVOKED, effective immediately.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This is a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within 14 days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the motion for reconsideration within 21 days of its receipt, or the motion will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Any such motion for reconsideration shall be served on the Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance, addressed as follows:

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order or orders previously issued in this case may file a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held;
- ii. The final agency action was taken;
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

A petition for judicial review must be filed within 28 days of: (a) the service date of this final order, (b) the service of an order denying motion for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within 21 days to grant or deny a motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. See Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal. Idaho Code § 67-5274.
