**ORDER PERMITTING DEVIATION  
FROM 2017 WORKERS'  
COMPENSATION RATES**

On or about October 25, 2016, the Idaho Department of Insurance (Department) received from BROTHERHOOD MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY (BROTHERHOOD MUTUAL), an Indiana-domiciled insurer licensed to transact workers' compensation insurance in the state of Idaho pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 3098, and a member of the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI), a request for permission to deviate from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2017 by a uniform percentage decrease of ten percent (10%).

BROTHERHOOD MUTUAL and the NCCI have each waived the right to a hearing on the deviation request.

The Department's Director (Director), having reviewed and being fully apprised of BROTHERHOOD MUTUAL's request to deviate from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2017, and the requirements of Idaho Code § 41-1614, has determined that the requested rate deviation is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1614, that BROTHERHOOD MUTUAL's request to deviate by a uniform percentage decrease of ten percent (10%) from the workers' compensation rates filed by the NCCI for 2017, exclusive of terrorism and catastrophe rating values, is GRANTED. This deviation from the Idaho workers' compensation premium rates filed by the NCCI for 2017 shall take effect on January 1, 2017, and shall remain in effect for one year from that date unless terminated sooner with the approval of the Director.
