**ORDER OF DEFAULT REVOKING
IDAHO NONRESIDENT
PRODUCER LICENSE**

The Director of the Idaho Department of Insurance (“Director”) having reviewed the record herein; and CHRISTINE MAE TAYLOR (“RESPONDENT”), who currently holds Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 596517, having been lawfully served the Verified Complaint and Notification of Rights, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, and having failed to file an answer thereto and having failed to request a hearing regarding said Verified Complaint; and the Director having found as a result thereof that

RESPONDENT has waived her rights regarding the opportunity for hearing; and in consideration of the above;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 596517 issued to RESPONDENT is REVOKED effective immediately and that, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1026(3), RESPONDENT shall not be issued any license under title 41, Idaho Code, for a period of one (1) year, after which RESPONDENT must petition and show good cause why this revocation should not be deemed a bar to the issuance of a new license.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that an administrative penalty in the amount of \$1,000 is imposed against RESPONDENT.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Idaho Code § 41-1027(2), that RESPONDENT shall immediately return Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 596517 to the Idaho Department of Insurance, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho 83720-0043.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

NOTIFICATION REGARDING REPORTABLE PROCEEDINGS

This is considered a reportable administrative proceeding. This information will be reported to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) and will appear in the Idaho Department of Insurance's online searchable database. Be aware that you may be required to disclose this proceeding on any license application, and you may be required to report this action to any and all states in which you hold an insurance license.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

This constitutes a final order of the agency. Any party may file a motion for reconsideration of this final order within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The agency will dispose of the petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5246(4).

Pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 67-5270 and 67-5272, any party aggrieved by this final order may appeal it by filing a petition for judicial review in the district court of the county in which: (1) the hearing was held; or (2) the final agency action was taken; or (3) the aggrieved party resides or operates its principal place of business in Idaho; or (4) the real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency decision is located. An appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of: (a) the service date of this final order, or (b) an order denying a petition for reconsideration, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration, whichever is later. *See* Idaho Code § 67-5273. The filing of a petition for judicial review to the district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

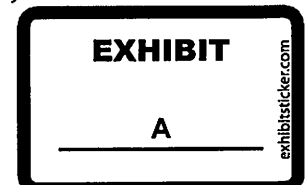

**VERIFIED COMPLAINT AND
NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS**

The Idaho Department of Insurance (hereinafter "Department"), by and through its attorney of record, John C. Keenan, Deputy Attorney General, does hereby complain and allege as follows:

1. The Director of the Department has jurisdiction in the state of Idaho over matters involving insurance regulation and licensing, in accordance with title 41, Idaho Code.

2. This administrative proceeding is brought under the provisions of the Idaho Insurance Code, Idaho Code § 41-101 *et seq.*, including Idaho Code § 41-1016, which authorizes



the Department to initiate a contested case against an Idaho-licensed insurance producer including an individual or an agency, seeking revocation of the insurance producer's license, as well as the imposition of administrative penalties in accordance with section 41-1016, Idaho Code, if the Director of the Department finds that any one or more of the causes or violations set forth in subsections (1)(a) through -(n) of that section exists.

3. Pursuant to section 41-1026(3), Idaho Code, the Director shall not issue a license under title 41, Idaho Code, to any person whose license has been revoked until after the expiration of not less than one (1) year to a maximum of five (5) years and, upon a former licensee's application for re-licensure, the Director may require the former licensee "to show good cause why the prior revocation ... shall not be deemed a bar to the issuance of a new license."

RESPONDENT

4. CHRISTINE MAE TAYLOR (hereinafter "Taylor") is a resident of the state of Florida and holds Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 596517, which was originally issued on November 21, 2016.

FACTS

5. On March 2, 2017, the Department sent to Taylor a request for information pursuant to section 41-247, Idaho Code, to her current mailing address and her email address on record at the Idaho Department of Insurance.

6. In a letter dated March 6, 2017, Taylor responded to the inquiry, but it was an incomplete response.

7. On April 18, 2017, Taylor was notified by the undersigned at her mailing address and her email address on record at the Idaho Department of Insurance that if she failed to fully respond, an action would be filed against her seeking revocation of her nonresident producer

license and an administrative fine.

8. On April 26, 2017, Taylor contacted the undersigned about her current situation and status; the undersigned gave Taylor two additional weeks to respond fully to the original inquiry, or no later than May 12, 2017.

9. As of the undersigned date, Taylor has not fully responded to the original inquiry.

10. By failing to fully respond, Taylor has violated section 41-247, Idaho Code, which gives the Department cause to seek revocation of Taylor's license and imposition of a monetary penalty, pursuant to section 41-1016(1)(b), Idaho Code.


PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Based on the foregoing, the Department prays for relief as follows:

1. That the Director find that Taylor violated the law as alleged; and
2. That the Director enter an order **REVOKING** Taylor's Idaho Nonresident Producer License No. 596517 and providing that Taylor shall not be issued any license under title 41, Idaho Code, for a period of one (1) year; and
3. That the Director enter an order imposing an administrative penalty against Taylor in the amount of \$1,000 per violation, for a total of \$1,000.00.

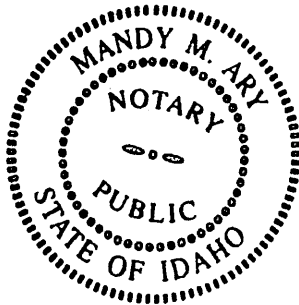




